APPEAL HEARING

Adopt Resolution 14-07 of the City Council of the City of Williams concurring with the proposed Modification to the Freeway Access Agreement.

DISCUSSION: Colusa County Public Works Director Lanphier explained to the members of the City Council that due to the Margurite Street and the State Route 20 Connection Project the State of California has requested a concurrence on the Draft Freeway Agreement that would supersede the Freeway Agreement that was last signed in the 1960's that designated a portion of



State Route 20 from Saltwater Creek to 0.8 miles east of Freshwater Road as a freeway. The Revised Draft Freeway Agreement would allow for a revised plan of said freeway. Lanphier also stated the section of Highway 20 from Interstate 5 to Husted Road will be a controlled access as designated.


