



City of Williams – Notice of Intent to Adopt a Mitigated Negative Declaration

Notice is hereby given that the City of Williams has tentatively determined that the project described below will not result in a significant adverse impact on the environment and that, in accordance with the California Environmental Quality Act, the City is prepared to issue a “mitigated negative declaration” in accordance with the California Environmental Quality Act:

Project Description: Construction of a rail dock cover of 31,850 square feet, and an additional proposed 9,600-square foot bin sorting building and cover at the existing Morning Star Packing Facility.

Project Location: 2211 Old Highway 99 West, Williams, CA 95987

This tentative determination is based on an environmental study that assesses the project’s potential environmental impacts. The environmental study includes a list of four (4) mitigation measures. Final environmental determinations are made by the decision making body, which, in this case would be the City of Williams, City Planner.
